RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Pina Colada Cake

1 Box Orange Cake Mix
2 Large Eggs
1 Cup Coconut
1 Cup of Water

Pineapple

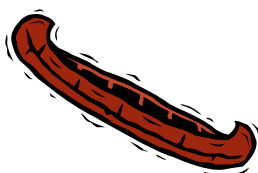
Thank you to all of the officers for their hard work and dedication and for taking the time to come and speak with us!
